POST SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIP

- Applicant must be registered with and in good standing with Hockey Saskatchewan and Battlefords Minor Hockey Association as a player or referee or have been registered for 3 consecutive years in the 6 years prior to graduation. (For clarification, an Applicant will be eligible if they are not able to play because they have a late birthday and have turned 18 prior to graduation).
- Applicant must graduate from one of the 3 local high schools in the current year.
- Applicant must intend to attend a post-secondary institution within 4 years.
- One scholarship will be awarded to a female player, male player and referee. Where there is no applicant for a category, the award designated shall not be awarded.

Applicants must submit:

- a. An essay outlining their Battlefords Minor Hockey experience, contributions to Minor Hockey, and contributions to the community.
- b. First semester transcripts and midterm marks

The scholarship will be paid to the successful candidate once they have provided an official Proof of enrolment (POE) from the post secondary institution they will be attending."

The successful applicants will be determined by a committee of 5 BMHA Board of directors.

Scholarships will be presented at graduation ceremonies by the BMHA President or designate.
